

GMAT/GRE Waiver Request Form

Overview

The Virginia Tech Evening MBA program will consider GMAT/GRE waiver requests on a case-by-case basis for the spring 2021 semester. Please note that approval of the waiver request is not guaranteed, and your request will undergo evaluation by the admissions committee whose decisions are final.

In order to be considered for a waiver, applicants must first begin their online graduate application and upload copies of their transcripts and their resume. These documents will be considered during the waiver review process. The application does not need to be formally submitted in order for the waiver request to reviewed.

For the purposes of this waiver request, the term "quantitative" refers to strong numbers-based courses, including but not limited to: calculus, corporate finance, accounting, statistics, quantitative methods, economics, appropriate engineering courses, etc.

 - Any relevant certificates requiring quantitative preparation
