Overview

The Virginia Tech Evening MBA program will consider spring 2022 GMAT/GRE waiver requests on a case-by-case basis for applicants who hold a graduate degree **or** applicants who have completed five years of professional experience **or** applicants who hold expired GMAT/GRE test scores. Please note that approval of the waiver request is not guaranteed, and your request will undergo evaluation by the admissions committee whose decisions are final.

For the purposes of this waiver request, the term “quantitative” refers to strong numbers-based courses, including but not limited to: calculus, corporate finance, accounting, statistics, quantitative methods, economics, appropriate engineering courses, etc.
