With the Evening MBA program, you have the flexibility to customize your degree by selecting courses and a timeline that aligns with your career goals and schedule. Students typically complete the program in 3.5 years, though options range from as few as two to as many as five years.

The Evening MBA program is 48 credit hours. The program consists of core courses, plus an international focused elective, and additional electives of your choosing.

CONSIDERING VALUE FOR YOUR INVESTMENT

Our Evening MBA program offers a competitive universal tuition rate, ensuring that students, regardless of their state of residence, enjoy the same rate. This means that students from DC, MD, VA, and beyond can attend a nationally-ranked top 30 program at a significantly lower cost compared to other part-time MBA programs in the greater Washington, D.C., metro area.

While many of our students are self-funded or apply for financial aid assistance, some also receive full or partial tuition assistance from their employers. We also award scholarships to a number of current students each semester. Visit our website to learn more.

TUITION

- \$1,100 per credit hour for both in-state and out-of-state residents
- Total estimated cost of the full 48-credit hour degree with fees is \$62,000+
- Books and supplies estimated at \$150 per course
