# EARN AN MBA AT YOUR OWN PACE

Students are not tied to a traditional full- or part-time MBA schedule with the Evening MBA program. Instead, you have the flexibility to tailor your degree by choosing the courses and timeline for completion that best fit your career goals and personal schedule. Some students complete their degree in as few as two years or as many as five, while the majority choose a three and half year plan of study.

Spring and Fall 2024 classes are offered on weekday evenings at our Northern Virginia Center, easily accessible by Metro, I-66, I-495 and Rt. 7. Each class meets once per week, so the number of courses you take each semester directly correlates to the number of evenings you'll be on campus. Starting Spring 2025, classes currently offered at the Northern Virginia Center will move to the new Innovation Campus (architect's rendering shown here) in Alexandria (Potomac Yard - VT Metro Station).

# CONSIDERING VALUE FOR YOUR INVESTMENT

Our Evening MBA program offers a competitive universal tuition rate, ensuring that students, regardless of their state of residence, enjoy the same rate. This means that students from DC, MD, VA, and beyond can attend a nationally-ranked top 30 program at a significantly lower cost compared to other part-time MBA programs in the greater Washington, D.C., metro area.

While many of our students are self-funded or apply for financial aid assistance, some also receive full or partial tuition assistance from their employers. We also award scholarships to a number of current students each semester. Visit our website to learn more.

## TUITION

- \$1,100 per credit hour for both in-state and out-of-state residents
- Total estimated cost of the full 48-credit hour degree with fees is \$63,000+
- Books and supplies estimated at \$150 per course
